MAP Scores

The Measurement of Academic Progress (MAP) scores were sent home with students today. If you did not pick up your student's MAP scores earlier this week, please be sure to ask your child for his or her MAP scores.

Students take the MAP tests twice a year, in September and again in April. The students take Reading, Language Usage and Math tests. The 7th graders also take a Science test. The students take the MAP tests on an iPad and they are able to work at their own pace. Parents are able to compare their child's progress from term to term Fall 2017 to Spring 2018 or from year to year Fall 2016 to Fall 2017, Spring 2017 to Spring 2018. A Quick Reference Guide has been included to assist with interpreting your child's scores.
