Low Grade Notices begin Monday, Sept. 9

Next week we will start our 3rd week of the quarter, so it's time to employ one of our "safety nets": Low Grade Notices & Study Tables. You should have received detailed information about Low Grade Notices & Study Tables in our mid-week update sent on Tuesday. Here are just a few quick reminders:

- The Low Grade Notice List is run on Monday Mornings (or the first day of the school week) for all 6th-8th grade students.
- Any student on the Low Grade List (70% or below) must meet with teachers in at least 2 study tables after school Monday, Tuesday, Thursday from 3:00-3:20 pm.
- A student is encouraged to meet with the teacher in whose class they have a low grade; however they are welcome to meet with any of their grade level teachers if their class teacher is unavailable.
- If your child's grade is not above a 70% by Thursday at 3:30 pm, your student will be ineligible for the upcoming weeks activities (that includes athletics and fine arts).

For next week's Low Grade report (**on Monday, Sept. 9th**), please note the following:

- The Low Grade report will only be run for 7th and 8th graders, since 6th graders are at Camp YAHOOO this week.
- Emails will be sent to students and parents with the essential information for Low Grade Notices - please stay tuned and check email regularly throughout the week.
